Educational Initiatives :



Powering Education through Eco-tech Digital Resource Centre:

After the pandemic has hit us, we have realised that education is one of the human development pillars which has been affected severely and schools have been struggling to cope with the situations. The entire school system is going through a difficult phase and facing numerous challenges. Efforts are now directed towards continuing education and providing access to all our teaching-learning materials, especially during the pandemic outbreak.

Hence, we launched our Eco-tech Digital Resource Centre. This is a digital knowledge sharing platform, which provides access to all teachers, students and even our parents to all the teaching- learning materials which they are missing out, due to the non-physical classroom situations. We strongly believe this will break all geographical barriers and ensure continuation of education.

Distribution of Students' Learning material, observing the COVID-19 Precautions:

While we migrated to the digital platform, we have also kept the sanctity of our original program intact, by distributing the hard copies of our students' learning materials to our partner schools, by observing the COVID-19 precautions. We took these special efforts so that children can continue their education sitting at home with the aid of our learning materials.

Introduction of Home-based learning Materials:

While the school education was completely stunted, we had to come up with quick solutions. Our Academic Team started working on home-based learning resources which we started sending to the schools to be further given to the students. These new learning resources were meant for children's practice and reinforcements.



Educational Initiatives :

Online Teachers' Training Programmes:

Understanding the precarious situation during this pandemic, Parisar Asha started extending help to the teachers' community by conducting free sessions on various trends of online teaching. Parisar Asha came across many teachers who have never been exposed to online teaching technologies. Parisar Asha took up this challenge and started orienting the teachers about the use of technology to enable classroom transactions. However, after continuous training and hand-holding, our teachers started adapting to new technologies for teaching, which they successfully used in creating interactive online classroom experiences. We received very positive response and now we feel we can successfully impart education and continue the process, even beyond the four walls of a traditional classroom.

Online Mentoring Sessions:

While the schools started slowly adapting to the new digital mode of learning, the teachers needed continuous hand holding to adapt to the new teaching mode and equip themselves with new teaching techniques. Hence, Parisar Asha's expert mentoring team started conducting regular mentoring sessions with the teachers of the associated schools to help them overcome the impediments. These sessions were used to train the teachers to effectively conduct the regular classes and sessions.



International Online Summer Camp :

We conducted two successful seasons of International Online Summer Camp between 19th April and 21st May'21 for children between age group 8 to 15 years. This was an initiative to engage children in fun-filled creative activities. During these sessions children learnt various forms of traditional and international art and craft. They also indulged into theatre activities and engaged in creative writing. It was an ideal way of unleashing the creative facets of the children while beating the boredom of the summer holidays. 107 children participated in this summer camp.





Between 31st May'21 to 11th June, Parisar Asha in collaboration with The Hindu conducted a week long summer camp for 170 children in two batches for age groups 7 to 10 years and 11 to 15 years. Separate activities were designed for the two age groups where the children indulged in fun-filled activities related to World Art, Traditional Art, Creative Lettering, Mind mapping, Speech and Drama and Language Enrichment.



Reading Club (FREE for all) to Increase Language Proficiency of Children

Language is a vital part of human connection. It has the power to build societies, but also to tear them down. While the countries are being shrunk to one global village, it becomes important to master the English language. Children, especially those hailing from the marginalised section, find communicating in English a daunting task with their strong vernacular foundations. This gap is all the more increasing, as the children are not attending their regular classes. In order to counter this, we started free reading clubs for two age groups - 7 to 10 years and 11 to 14 years. This club is conducted by our language experts aimed at inculcating the reading habit among children which is somewhere getting lost due to the heavy insurgence of the digital media. The efforts are also directed at improving language skills and we have seen stark difference among children, two months after they joined the club. In the last one year, we have reached out to more than 437 students.



Spoken English to Increase Language Proficiency of Children



It is often found that children struggle in proficiently using the English language as they hail from vernacular backgrounds. This gap all the more increased, as the children were not attending their regular classes. In order to counter this, we started Spoken English sessions for two age groups - 7 to 10 years and 11 to 14 years. These sessions were conducted by our language experts aimed at improving their reading and writing skills. The efforts were directed at holistically improving language skills. In the last one year we reached out to more than 420 students.





Online Eco-friendly Ganpati Workshops

Last two years have been devastating while Covid-19 had engulfed human civilization. Among such a catastrophic scenario, humans yearned for some positivity, hope and joy to recuperate from the loss and grief. And what better way can it be than celebrating our beloved Ganpati festival.

However, while the situations were tough and with the norms of social distancing, we decided to conduct the workshops online and still uphold the spirit of this beautiful festival. This year, we once again like the previous year conducted the Ganpati making workshop through digital platform and taught the participants the process of making Ganpati idols using eco- friendly materials which were easily available, within the secured walls of their homes. This helped us to reach to many more participants and go beyond the geographical boundaries of Maharashtra and conduct multiple sessions. This mode of imparting trainings about Ganpati idol making helped us to encourage people to maintain social distance and decrease the number of footfalls in the Ganpati idol selling shops and help us contain the spread of COVID-19.

In this mission we collaborated with The Hindu and together we conducted 6 workshops and reached out to 446 children.



Mom & Me Summer Camp:

A special one-week summer camp was organised for toddlers between the age group of 4 to 6 years along with their mothers. In this camp fun-filled activities were organised where mothers participated with their children engaged with them as they explored the world of art, craft and storytelling. 25 enthusiastic participants participated in this summer camp.

















Million Caring Citizens Programme : Green Army Family initiative supported by Mahindra Lifespaces

School Transformation Programme in Private Schools Supported by National Oilwell Varco (NOV)

Vesawa Vidya Mandir School / Hebron English School / Our Lady of Dolours

After the schools faced a major jolt in 2020 due to the pandemic, schools were desperately looking for solutions to reach out to their students and provided them access to the learning material. This was also the time when the schools were trying to empower themselves and go back to the 'new normal'. During such dire times Vesawe Vidya Mandir, Hebron English School and Our Lady of Dolours reached out to Parisar Asha seeking help for empowering their school and realign the academic needs of the children.

Parisar Asha was delighted to take these schools under its wing with the support of NOV. In all these three schools we extended our intervention from Jr. KG to Std IV. We reworked on our strategies. Previously we used a school-based learning approach and now we used home-based learning. During this one year of intervention, we concentrated on developing the children's Physical Development, Academic development, Social Development, emotional development, language development and cognitive development. As a part of the programme, Parsiar Asha also conducted a lot of enrichment workshops for children on various topics. Std VII to Std X students were given access to Study Circles where they received handholding from engineering students from premier institutes in Maths and science. Additionally, children were also encouraged to take part in our reading club for language development.



We rolled out the program very successfully and reached out to 965 students 19 teachers.





Art in the school curriculum?

In art there is no right or wrong. Through art, students can express themselves freely with a decisionmaking power. This works wonders when the child grows up. It becomes easier for parents to raise a happy child. When we use art as a media for teaching methodology, learning becomes a joyful experience.

Q: According to you, the word environment refers not necessarily to nature but to one's spiritual, social and academic environment. How does the academic and social environment of a student influence his/her all round development?

A child's social and academic environment plays a very important role in
